And here's some more facts to consider: The career services site CareerCast.com released its list of the 12 best jobs in 2014, with actuary being a top career choice. And the Illinois Department of Employment Statistics forecasts continued growth in the actuarial industry, with a predicted starting salary of \$60,960. That compares to a starting salary of \$20,400 across all occupations in the state.
